About the role

Youth work supports a young person's personal, social and educational development. We use youth work to explore their values and beliefs, to enable them to develop their voice and place in society, and to learn skills that help them to realise their full potential.

You will manage the boxing sessions and supervise young people. You will also establish positive relationships with young people; challenging, supporting and encouraging them as they develop.

Main Responsibilities:

- To maintain high ethical standards in coaching and prepare all coaching sessions in advance in line with England Boxing regulations.
- To a high-quality boxing programme with children and young people aged 8-19 years old (21 with a disability) to lead and deliver safe and structured sessions within BLGC.
- To develop and deliver inclusive sessions focused on increasing girls' participation in boxing.
- To support and contribute to maintaining relevant club charter and standard marks.
- To liaise with governing bodies and ensure all regulations are kept up to date in terms of staff training, legislation, health and safety and other relevant policy issues.
- To be a positive role model, creating a positive and fun environment in which to motivate and encourage young people to participate in sport or physical activity.
- To ensure that young people maintain a high standard of behaviour and discipline during sessions.
- Effectively communicate at all levels.
- Be able to work on own initiative including being flexible to meet the needs of children and young people.
- Promote cultural cohesion and inclusion, and proactively challenge any prejudice and discrimination.
- To have responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people at all times.

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- To monitor, record and evaluate sessions in accordance with BLGC’s systems.
- To be an active member of the team and deliver a focused, measurable contribution operating in line with BLGC’s vision and values.
- Always seek to continuously improve so that the highest quality standards are achieved.
- Participate positively in internal/external meetings and training as required.
- Ensure that all relevant policies, procedures and working practices are adhered to at all times.
- Act as a positive ambassador for BLGC at all times.
- Be flexible and willing to undertake any other duties that may be reasonably be required.
- To ensure Health and Safety standards are maintained and all participants are provided with safe and secure sessions.
- To ensure that equipment is set up safely and securely and checked prior to each session and reporting any issues to the Sport Development Manager.
- To undertake session administrative duties as required by the role, in particular ensuring the completion of daily written registers and attendances and providing regular updates on session delivery and progress.
- To act in a responsible and appropriate manner at all times in accordance with the England Boxing Code of Conduct, ethics, and best practice, reporting any concerns to the Sport Development Manager.
